THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS FOR INCORRECT ENTRIES**

1. This event is run under EA/FEI rules & regulations. Including the following:
 - a. FEI Code of Conduct for the Welfare of the Horse
 - b. EA Code of Conduct for Conflict of Interest
 - c. FEI Code of Conduct for Jumping Warm Up Arenas
 - d. EA Code of Conduct Australian Helmet Standards
2. Australian Helmet Standards will apply. All riders must wear riding boots and an approved helmet at all times whilst mounted, including presentations.
3. All riders and owners must be financial members of EA to compete in official Classes (1.05m and over). All horses competing in official Classes must hold current EA registration and performance cards. Riders may be required to present horse registration/performance cards upon request of the committee.
4. All riders in events under 1.05m need to hold EA Competitor or Participant membership and all horses need to have a current EA base or life registration. EA memberships & registrations will be verified.
5. All riders competing at the event will be deemed to have read and accepted the Conditions of Entry, as evidenced by ticking the Agree Box prior to completion of your entry on Global Entries Online.
6. After any fall anywhere at Stonewall, the rider must be cleared by the Medical Services Provider BEFORE re-mounting.
7. The OC reserves the right to change or amend the program, conditions, regulations, or any aspect of the event as they see fit.
8. The OC reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry.
9. All owners and competitors will be personally responsible for damages to any third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their animals.
10. Draw Order – Ring One will follow draw order. Should a horse need to be moved down the draw for exceptional reasons, the marshal shall communicate with the Judge to allow this. Ring 2 will be whiteboard.
11. Number of Starts:
 - a. A horse can have two starts in consecutive Classes.
 - b. Where there are concurrent classes (as in a,b,c sections), a rider may start in both sections of a concurrent class but on different horses.
12. Refunds will be given in full before close of entries, less a \$25 administration fee, please contact the OC as refunds are not done automatically. After entries have closed, a 50% refund will be given on presentation of a veterinary or doctor's certificate.
13. Entry Changes
 - a. Are allowed at no charge via Live Editing
 - b. Will incur a \$10 fee if made outside Live Editing hours and must be made at the office.
 - c. No HC entries allowed. Only 1 round per horse per class.
14. Presentation of Prizes – Prizes for each class will be awarded immediately following the event.
15. GST – is included in all fees and charges and Prizemoney.
16. Prizemoney will be paid through Global Entries Online. Please ensure your details are up to date
17. SCOOTERS – are allowed at Stonewall but riders must wear their riding helmets
18. Dogs & Prams
 - a. Dogs must be on a lead at all times
 - b. Dogs and prams are not allowed in the warm up or competition arenas
19. **Young Horse Boot Rule** – For any class or section of a class with an age requirement or limitation, the YH Boot Rule will apply. For all classes with concurrent sections where one section is for Young Horses, the Young Horse Boot Rule will apply to all sections of that class. Art 257 EA Jumping Rules, 1 July 2023

Complaints And Protests

All complaints or protests in any way related to the event, whether valid or not, will not be considered by the Organising Committee unless they are presented in legible writing, accompanied by \$50 and duly signed by a single clearly identified person. Protests must be received within 15 minutes of the completion of the class. When a letter is being presented on behalf of a group, it is that group's responsibility to nominate a person to sign it on their behalf. Whether any letter of complaint or protest is acted upon or not is at the sole discretion of the Organising Committee.

THE COMMITTEE HAS THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ENTRY TO THE EVENT TO ANY PERSON AND ALSO REFUSE TO ACCEPT ANY ENTRIES INTO THE COMPETITION.
